This will be a conference for IUFRO Working Group 2.08.03 – Improvement and Culture of Eucalypts. It will focus on benefits, issues, and technologies associated with improving the development, growth and management of eucalypt plantations.

This conference to be held in Zhanjiang, Guangdong Province, China, from 21-24 October 2015 (suggested day for arrival & registration is 20 October 2015). It will bring together world experts, practitioners, managers and policy makers involved with the growing and utilization of eucalypts.

This field tour will visit a range of prime eucalypt plantation regions of Guangdong and Guangxi provinces to see a diverse range of plantations, management operations, eucalypt nurseries, R&D field trials and processing industries.
