We are happy to tell you that the 1st Asian Air Pollution Workshop (AAPW) was successfully held at the University of Tokyo from 31<sup>st</sup> of October to 2<sup>nd</sup> of November, 2015. All the participants to the workshop hopefully enjoyed the discussions on the main topic of the workshop: air pollution impacts on vegetation, as well as other scientific and cultural issues of importance.

To repeat the success of the AAPW-1, we are going to organize the 2nd AAPW (AAPW-2) in Beijing on 22<sup>nd</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup> of October in this year. The venue is the home institute (RCEES, <a href="http://english.rcees.cas.cn/">http://english.rcees.cas.cn/</a>) of one of us (ZF). - 4. Modelling and monitoring of air pollution effects on vegetation, and
- 5. Interaction between air pollution and climate change in the impacts on vegetation.

In terms of the meeting structure, we will follow that of AAPW-1: a half-day introductory session with 3-4 keynote presentations, two half-day discussion sessions, and a half-day concluding session.
