The dialogue aims to facilitate an exchange of perspectives and lessons learned on opportunities, challenges, and pathways to increase access to and benefits from Fast-Growing Trees (FGTs) in the context of Africa's transition to the Bioeconomy. Through a review of successful examples and country case studies, this side event will explore FGT production systems and value chain development, considering socioeconomic, environmental, and governance issues. The event will also feature discussions on the most recent research on FGTs for wood production and bioeconomy support in Africa. Policymakers, researchers, and industry experts are invited to assess policies and science guiding the expansion of sustainable wood use in the bioeconomy.
