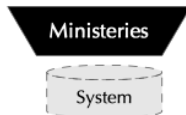

Uncoordinated policy instruments

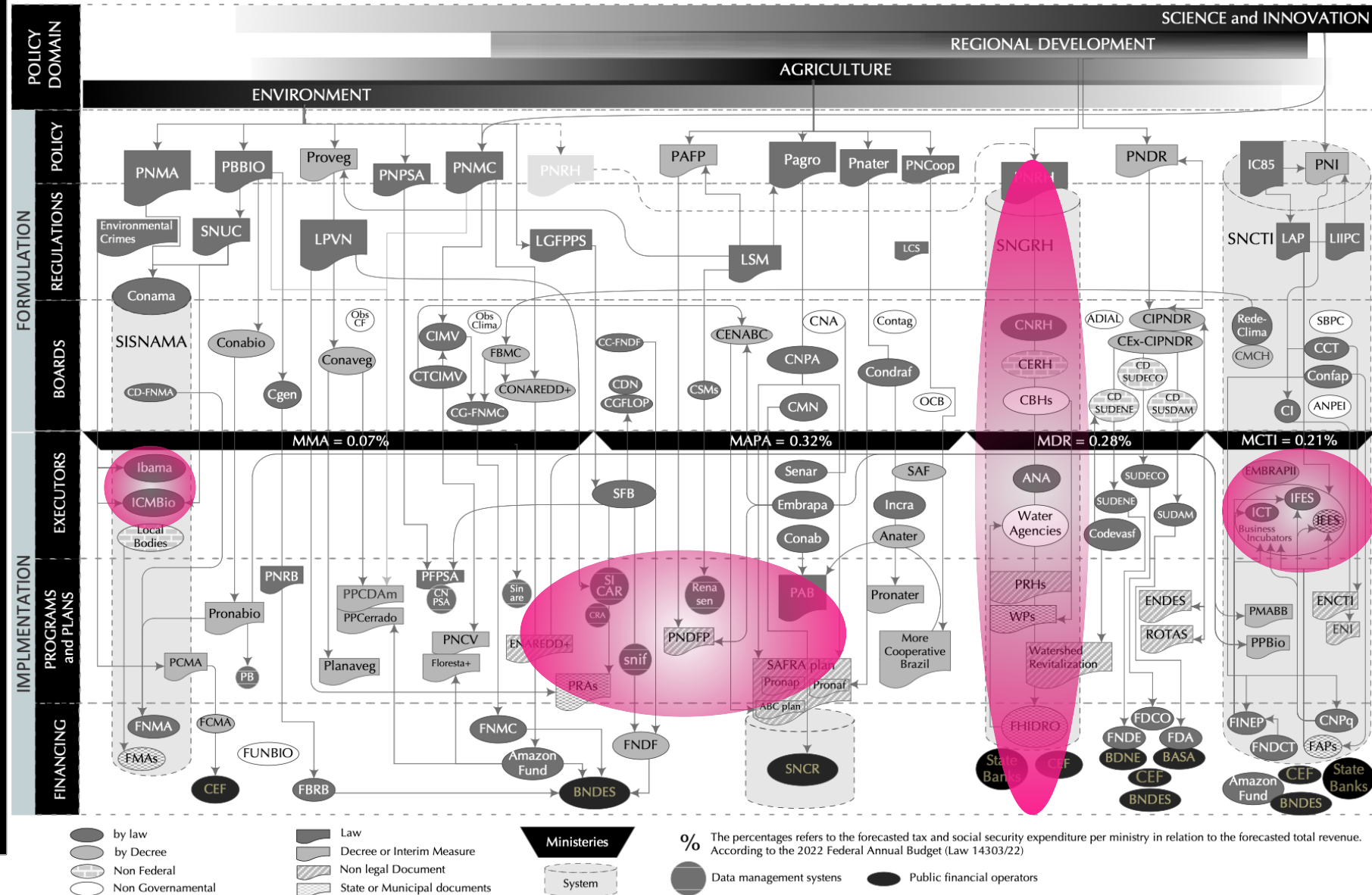
policy instruments are **dispersed**, responding to **poorly integrated** policies

MMA-> licensing (Ibama, ICMBio)

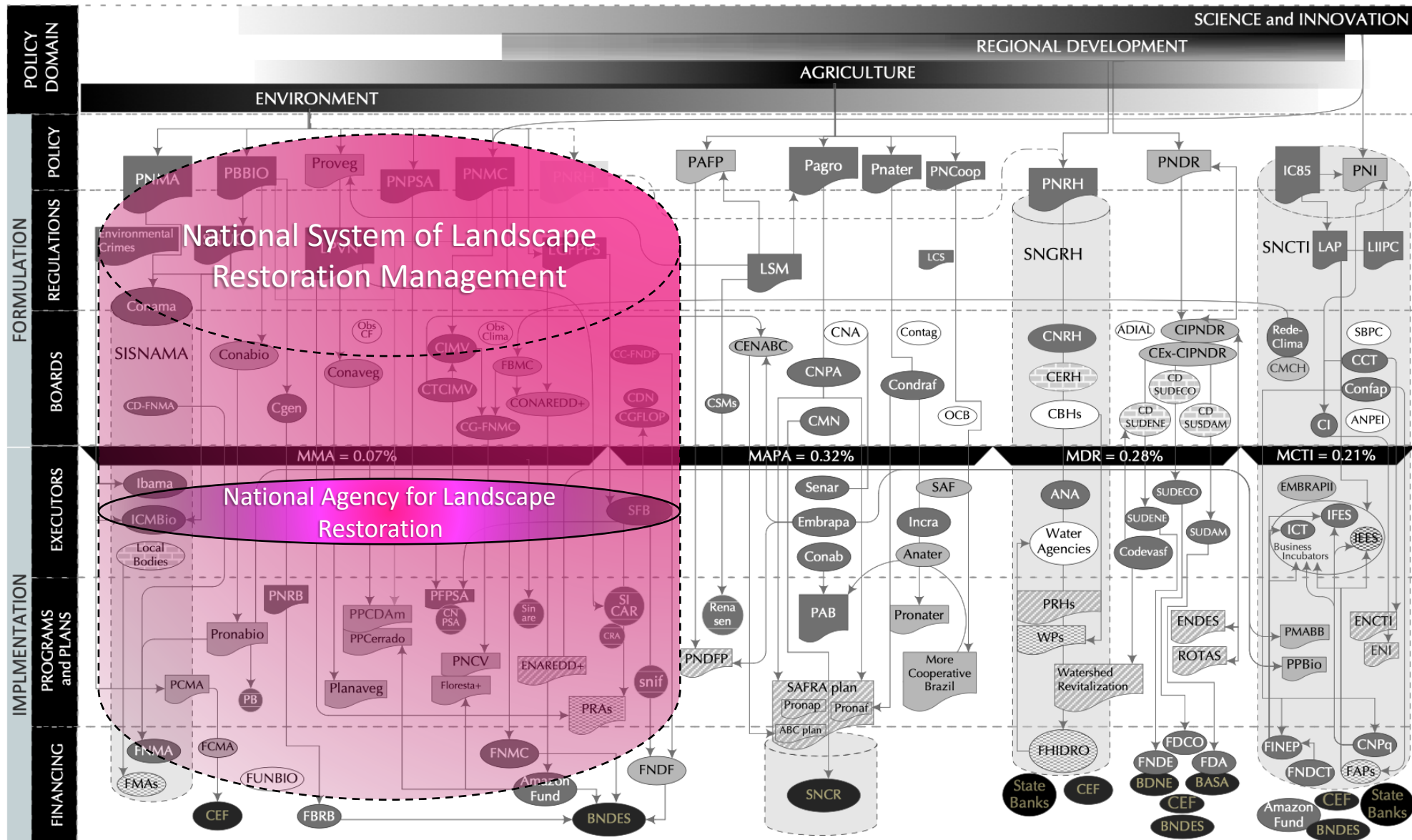
MAPA-> implementing (Renasem, PRAs, Si-CAR, CRA, ABC plan)
