1) Call for Abstracts: Aftermath and revisions

The Call for Abstracts was officially closed 15. December at midnight. On afternoon, the rate of submissions climbed to almost one abstract per minute!

In the end, we received **almost 3,500 abstracts**, submitted by **about 2,800 researchers** from **110 countries**.

Thanks to all of you for this overwhelming response!

We are overjoyed by your tremendous interest in celebrating the 125th Anniversary of the IUFRO together with us in Freiburg.

This response underlines not only the importance and impact of IUFRO in the scientific world, but also highlights the substantial enthusiasm and eagerness of its members to contribute to a sustainable and green future.

As this congress is embedded between the World Congresses in Salt Lake City, USA (2014) and Curitiba, Brazil (2019), we initially expected about half that number of participants in Freiburg for this rather “spontaneous” event.

For us, this implies a substantial rethinking and re-planning the congress, including schedule and side events as well as logistics and infrastructure.

Our marked goal is to make this a successful and unforgettable event for as many of you as possible!

Thus, 2017 will be a very busy and very exciting year here in the organization office and for the affiliated NFZ officeholders and organizers.

We are looking forward to a creative and buzzing time and hope to have an extraordinary celebration for you in September!

2) Current Congress Schedule

In order to allow a maximum participation of presenters, we have extended the congress by one more day.

The main congress program will thus be scheduled from **Monday, 18th September through to Friday, 22nd September**.

Beforehand, the NFZ partners are organizing several **summer schools** and **side events**
