# IUFRO Special Programme for Developing Countries

## - Progress Report 2001 -

### Personnel

After more than 2 years at SPDC in Vienna, Dr. David Langor returned to his research position in Canada at the end of June 2001. As his successor, IUFRO employed Dr. Michael Kleine under a financing agreement with the German Government through BMZ/GTZ. The outgoing and incoming Co-ordinators worked together during the month of June 2001, in order to ensure a smooth handing-over of duties. In March 2001 Administrative Assistant, Ms Eva Schimpf, went on maternity leave. Her position was filled by Ms Birgit Buxbaum.

### Planning

An international advisory group was established with the intention to serve as a discussion forum to support IUFRO-SPDC in planning and evaluating its activities and projects. This group provided valuable input into the formulation of a revised strategic plan. The plan provides the framework for action in the period 2002-2005 and highlights the priorities for the three components: training, collaborative networking and scientist assistance. In addition, project planning was undertaken in cooperation with potential partners such as IUFRO Task Forces, FAO, GTZ and FORSPA.

### Project Operations

**Project 1 GFIS Africa:** This 3-year project funded by the EC DG Development, completed its second year of implementation. Project operations progressed according to plan. Five GFIS nodes hosted by IUFRO partner institutions were established in Africa, including the supply of the necessary hard-and software and the training of webmasters and information managers.

**Project 2 Carpathian Mountain Project:** With the wrap-up workshop held in Slovakia in May, this project was completed.

**Project 3 Preparing and Writing Research Proposals:** A translation of the English version of the handbook on Proposal Writing into French was undertaken in co-operation with FOAFRI (Gabon), a forest research co-operation implemented by CIRAD Forêt and CIFOR in Central Africa. Training workshops were held in Kenya, Iran and Cameroon involving some 75 participants. The workshops were organised by IFS, and SPDC contributed through the provision of English and French handbooks. IFS and SPDC plan follow-up workshops in 2002 in Burkina Faso, Cote d'Ivoire and Togo.

### Project 4 BIO-REFOR:

Funded by ODA (Japan), this project had provided substantial support to SPDC for over 10 years. SPDC received about US\$ 150,000 in February 2001. Those funds were used for the BIO-REFOR Workshop in Tokyo (2001) and for general operations and projects.

### Project 5 Scientist Assistance Programme (SAP):

After the SPDC funding base for this programme had been exhausted at the end of 2000, the SAP was suffering from a permanent lack of funds. Because of changes in donor policy and overall scarcity of funds for development in the forestry sector, donors do not want to provide funds to a third party to be used for travel assistance. In order to adapt to this situation, the SAP was re-organised and a new strategy was formulated.

### Administration and Finances

Work in SPDC administrative matters concentrated on streamlining the office management and the processes of internal accounting. In addition, project management according to existing agreements with the GFIS Africa Project took about 60% of all the work carried out.

Recurrent expenditures such as salaries of SPDC staff, travel costs of the Co-ordinators, and administrative overheads for printing, postage, telecommunications, office supplies, leasing, equipment and auditing were financed from the SPDC core fund budget. In 2001 those expenditures amounted to a total of US\$ 230,678. Income in 2001 included mainly contributions from DANIDA, ODA (Japan) and some smaller earnings from the sales of publications, project management and interest. Overall, a surplus of income of US\$ 30,734 can be reported. This surplus is needed to keep the operations going in 2002 and simultaneously achieve a non-declining core funding base. The German-funded project through BMZ/GTZ provides the salary for the Co-ordinator and is based on a three-year financing Agreement between GTZ and IUFRO. The project is being implemented according to plan.

# SilvaVoc Terminology Project

## - Progress Report 2001 -

### Introduction

The activities in 2001 aimed at consolidating the project work and improving the information given at the SilvaVoc website and in the SilvaTerm terminology database. In addition, the OeNB (Austrian National Bank) agreed in June 2001 to fund a IUFRO-SilvaVoc project proposal for a carbon cycling multilingual glossary.

### SilvaVoc website

The mission of the SilvaVoc project is to ensure high quality in terminology work and to provide services related to forest terminology. The following services are, among others, accessible from the SilvaVoc website:

- International Bibliography of glossaries, dictionaries and other terminological publications: access to bibliographic data of and links to on-line glossaries in forestry and related areas in the four IUFRO and other languages.
- SilvaTerm terminology database: access to the meaning of the most frequently used terms in forestry. A technical term is presented together with a definition and additional explanations and with the respective IUFRO research unit which has approved the information provided. Equivalent terms are given in up to eight languages (English, French, Spanish, German, Italian, Japanese, Hungarian, Portuguese and some terms in Swahili)
- Abbreviations: access to abbreviations and acronyms of general terms and of organizations in forestry
- Related Projects: information about related terminology projects, from small glossary projects on specific subject fields, to global monolingual dictionary projects and the discussion of specialized terms
- In-house terminology: explanation of IUFRO specific terminology
- Archives: a guide through the proceedings of the MEXFT'98 Workshop organized together with 6.03.02, and a Short Guide about terminology management in forestry.

### Carbon Cycling Terminology

The project examines possible confusion due to the existence of terms in International Agreements that are not clearly defined or not accepted on a national level. The result will be a multilingual glossary on carbon cycling of approximately 300 terms which also highlights

terms which may cause confusion because of diverging interpretation.

The proposed procedure includes the following steps:

- Establish a network of carbon cycling experts willing to co-operate in the terminology project
- Identify the authoritative carbon subject field literature and find out if there are national standards in the field
- Search the relevant texts and define a list of key terms in each working language
- Co-operating experts to review these lists
- World-wide literature review and Internet survey for definitions of these terms
- Harmonize the different language parts and highlight the terms of diverging interpretation
- Co-operating experts to review the resulting definitions and draft publication
- Publish the glossary on paper and on the Internet and distribute it for use.

### International Cooperation

In November 2001 a cooperation with P. Sigaud, FAO was finalized and resulted in a multilingual (English, French, Spanish and German) on-line glossary (<http://iufro.boku.ac.at/iufro/silvavoc/glossary>) on forest genetic resources, which presents 41 FGR terms with a reference definition and additional definitions in use by various organizations. A Memorandum of Understanding was signed in December 2001 to continue with another 20 terms.

## How Division Officers Conduct Business

### 1. Communication

Communications among Research Group (RG) Coordinators Working Party (WP) Coordinators, the Division Coordinator, and their Deputies is the grease which allows Division machinery to function. Communication should flow in all directions. Divisions will function better than they have, if we all communicate better. For example, if you are a WP Deputy Coordinator, and have not been in touch with your WP Coordinator for a while, send him/her a letter, fax, email or phone call! Constant communication with the Secretariat is also important. WP Coordinators report to the Research Group Coordinators, who in turn report to the Division Coordinator. The Coordinator then reports to the Secretariat and the Board.

### 2. Funding

Over the last 30 years, as IUFRO has spread from Europe to other industrialized nations, then to less-industrialized nations, the issue of funding IUFRO activities has become more and more of a problem. But please keep in mind that funding is usually question #3. Questions #1 & #2 are: What fantastic idea or project is being proposed?, and Who is the ideal person to make that idea or project work? Once those questions are answered, the issue of funding often is settled quite easily. If the officer's employer is unable to offer basic support and there are no other sources apparently available, then here are two suggestions: 1) choose additional officers (Deputies) who will have better funding support, and/or 2) find a way to operate the group at a lower-

cost level. Items such as mailing costs should be borne by the Member Organization, i.e. the officer's institute. In case of difficulties, contact the IUFRO Secretary, who may find a way to support you.

### 3. SPDC

The Special Programme for Developing Countries, based at the IUFRO Secretariat in Vienna, serves a variety of functions, one of which is to help developing-country scientists attend IUFRO meetings. The programme of individual support to attend meetings was discontinued in early 2000, but the SPDC Coordinator can be of help in the writing of project proposals to donors in order to obtain financial support for a IUFRO meeting or workshop. (The SPDC does not offer grants for post-graduate education).

### 4. Stepping down

We are all volunteers in our IUFRO assignments, with other, full-time jobs. Now and then a Division officer finds it difficult to have enough time to manage the IUFRO job along with the full-time job. In such a case, please notify your Research Group Coordinator or Division Coordinator immediately; try to have in mind a logical person to replace you. Inactive groups are often eliminated because officers have become inactive, not because the subject matter is unimportant. Let's keep all groups vigorous!

### 5. Deputies and Co-chairs

Each Research Group and Working Party should have more than one officer. The Coordinator is usually the one best able to find and recommend a Deputy, keeping in mind the need to strive for a geographic balance. Coordinators and Deputies of Research Groups are approved by the Board, Coordinators and Deputies of Working Parties are approved by the Division Coordinator. Also keep in mind the 2-term limit (five years per term) for most positions.

### 6. Activities

What does a Research Group or Working Party officer do? There is a wide variety of answers to that question, depending on the talents, wishes, funding sources and energies available among the officers of a group.

Research Groups or Working Parties (in general called "IUFRO Units" or only "Units") often do one or more of the following:

- issue a newsletter once or twice a year (sometimes in two languages) which might include research news of interest, IUFRO-specific news, future meetings of interest to the group etc. When done well, this alone can be a low-budget, sufficient group activity. Be sure to send copies of your newsletter to the Division Coordinator and to the Secretariat!
- send also an electronic version of your newsletter to the mailing list of your Unit (and the Secretariat).
- hold a meeting: Research Groups may hold a technical session at the IUFRO Congress, and should hold one or more meetings during the five-year term; WPs usually do not have sessions at the Congress, but hold meetings or workshops between Congresses.
- manage the content of your Unit's homepage on IUFRO's website by submitting relevant material for the following pages: About Unit, Events and Activities, Publications and References, Newsletter, Fields of Interest, State-of-Knowledge Reports and Links to other Information Resources to your Division WebModerator.
- supply information about meetings to the Secretariat for the Calendar of Meetings on the IUFRO website.
- publish a book, based often on papers given at the Congress or at between-Congress meetings. Also: IUFRO offers a "World Series" as well as a Research Series for publishing top quality research results and/or important material. In addition, IUFRO publishes a series called "Occasional Papers", intended for presenting shorter papers and regional topics.
- contribute to the quarterly IUFRO News by sending reports of meetings, special announcements or appropriate articles to the Secretariat.
- arrange with a technical journal to have Congress papers or papers from other meetings published in a single or special issue.
- conduct a scientific study tour which offers group members opportunity to see first-hand the most recent applications of research results, or problems in need of research.
- prepare a multi-lingual glossary of terms for the subject matter of interest to the Unit. Submit your terms and definitions to IUFRO's Terminology Project *SilvaVoc* at the Secretariat. But beware: IUFRO has done several of these over the last 100 years, and may have already done the one you are proposing!
- prepare a short annual activity report, based on the recommendation of the Division Coordinator - usually submitted by the end of November.
- conduct joint research projects.
- use your imaginations; offer us new ideas to add to this list!

## Benefits of IUFRO Membership

### What is IUFRO?

IUFRO is one of the oldest international organizations having been established in 1892. According to the Internal Regulations the basic annual membership fee for Member Organizations is 200 EURO. In addition, each Member Organization pays 90 EURO for every 10 researchers. Thus, the minimum fee for any Member Organization is 290 EURO. The annual fee for Associate Members is 80 EURO. The annual membership fee can also be paid in US dollars (\$).
